



Fig.1 Grounded Emitter Propagation Characteristics





Fig.2 Typical Output Characteristics

Fig.3 DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current(I)





Fig.4 DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current(II)

Fig.5 Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current(I)




Fig.6 Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current(II)




Fig.7 Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current





Fig.8 Gain Bandwidth Product vs. Emitter Current

capacitance vs. Collector-Base Voltage



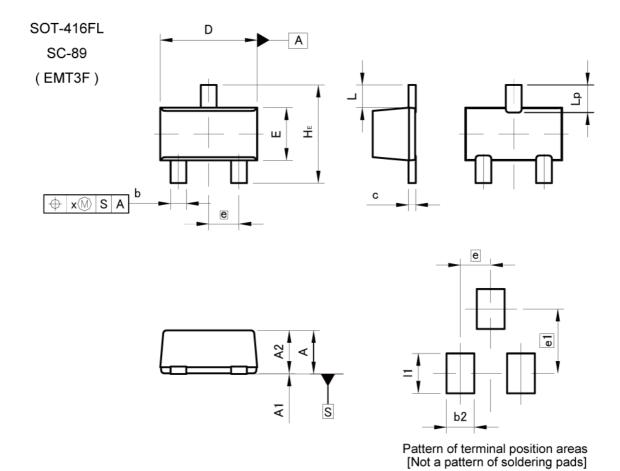
