 operating time may result in exceeding a limit acceptable to the specific application, thereby establishing a functional lifetime.
- (1) The power dissipation on the resistor generates a temperature rise against the local ambient, depending on the heatflow support of the printed-circuit board (thermal resistance). The rated dissipation applies only if the permitted film temperature is not exceeded. Furthermore, a high level of ambient temperature or of power dissipation may raise the temperature of the solder joint, hence special solder alloys or board materials may be required to maintain the reliability of the assembly.







DESCRIPTION

Production of the CMB 0207 specialty MELF resistor is strictly controlled and follows an extensive set of instructions established for reproducibility. A homogeneous and dense carbon film is deposited on a high grade ceramic body (Al $_2$ O $_3$). Nickel plated steel termination caps are firmly pressed on the coated rods. Products with a resistance of 15 Ω or lower are made without trimming, whereas a special laser is used to achieve a target value of 16 Ω or above by smoothly cutting a helical groove in the resistive layer without damaging the ceramics. The resistor elements are covered by a protective coating designed for electrical, mechanical and climatic protection. The terminations receive a final pure tin on nickel plating. Four color code rings designate the resistance value and tolerance in accordance with IEC 60 062 (3).

The result of the determined production is verified by an extensive testing procedure performed on 100 % of the individual resistors. Only accepted products are laid directly into the blister tape in accordance with **IEC 60 286-3** ⁽³⁾.

ASSEMBLY

The resistors are suitable for processing on automatic SMD assembly systems. They are suitable for automatic soldering using wave, reflow or vapour phase as shown in **IEC 61760-1** ⁽³⁾. The encapsulation is resistant to all cleaning solvents commonly used in the electronics industry, including alcohols, esters and aqueous solutions. The suitablility of conformal coatings, if applied, shall be qualified by appropriate means to ensure the long-term stability of the whole system. The resistors are RoHS compliant, the pure tin plating provides compatibility with lead (Pb)-free and lead containing soldering processes. The immunity of the plating against tin whisker growth has been proven under extensive testing.

All products comply with the **GADSL** ⁽¹⁾ and the **CEFIC-EECA-EICTA** ⁽²⁾ list of legal restrictions on hazardous substances. This includes full compliance with the following directives:

- 2000/53/EC End of Vehicle life Directive (ELV) and Annex II (ELV II)
- 2002/95/EC Restriction of the use of Hazardous Substances Directive (RoHS)
- 2002/96/EC Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Directive (WEEE)

Solderability is specified for 2 years after production or requalification. The permitted storage time is 20 years.









HISTORICAL 12NC INFORMATION

- The subsequent 4 digits indicate the resistor type, specification and packaging; see the 12NC table.
- The remaining 4 digits indicate the resistance value:
 - The first 3 digits indicate the resistance value.
 - The last digit indicates the resistance decade in accordance with the 12NC Indicating Resistance Decade table.
