<b>Product</b>	<b>Brass Restorer</b>
<b>Type</b>	Acidic solution.
<b>Intended Use</b>	Removing tarnish from brass, copper and bronze.
<b>Special Features</b>	Can also be used on new galvanised steel to act as a mordant solution, and on aluminium to etch a surface.
<b>Preparation</b>	Wipe surface free from grease and dirt. Remove any existing lacquer with <b>Rustin's Strypit Paint &amp; Varnish Stripper</b> .
<b>Application</b>	Apply liberally with a brush and leave until the tarnish is removed.
<b>Coats</b>	One application should be sufficient. Small items may be dipped.
<b>Drying Time</b>	N/A.
<b>Re-coating Time</b>	N/A.
<b>Application Temp.</b>	Ideally 15-25 °C
<b>Coverage</b>	N/A.
<b>Maintenance</b>	Use when required. Cleaned metal should be protected with <b>Rustins Metal Lacquer</b> to prevent re- tarnishing.
<b>Compatibility</b>	N/A
<b>Settlement</b>	Shake thoroughly before use.
<b>Shelf-life/Storage</b>	A very long time if stored in a cool dry place with the lid firmly secured to provide an airtight seal.
<b>Hazards</b>	Corrosive, Flammable. Causes burns. Keep out of reach of children. Wear suitable protective clothing, gloves and eye/face protection. After contact with skin wash immediately with water. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice. <b>Clean-Up</b>	Before repainting clean with Methylated Spirits. Equipment should be cleaned with water.
